Based on the pillars and the favourable policy context defined by the EU's horizontal legislation for data sharing and the European strategy for data, this session will be focused on the multiple perspectives (scientific, policy, technical, organisational) that should converge in order to make the data spaces concept a success. Several specific topics will be presented and discussed, ranging from the empirical evidence for data sharing approaches of SMEs, the national perspective on data spaces, the scientific evidence in support of the establishment of data spaces as well as the infrastructure and enabling open source technologies.
