About this session:

Transparency can instil trust and credibility in all sorts of sustainability claims: eco-design pledges for products, corporate sustainability claims of "climate neutrality", "permanence" & "additionality" claims by carbon capture credits, national carbon inventories or even energy performance claims for buildings.

Transparency means to make accessible evidence underpinning the claims to those who need to know: auditors & verifiers, buyers or investors, the public sector, the civil society acting as a watchdog for these claims e.g. NGOs, academia, citizens

The Green Deal Data Space can deliver a scalable data and IT infrastructure to ensure transparency about these claims for those who need to know in view of the exponential surge of claims in pursue of climate neutrality.

This session will focus on relevant use-cases related to transparency of sustainability claims from the angle of enabling technologies plus spatial and non-spatial data
