About this session:

Adopted by the European Commission in December 2022, the Implementing Act on High-value Datasets aims “to make more publicly funded information available for new information products and innovation, in particular in artificial intelligence”. This session will discuss how High-values datasets (HVDs) can act as a mechanism for unlocking data and improving the availability and accessibility of data for the Green Deal data space. Participants will elaborate on good practices, challenges, and opportunities of implementing HVDs in the current and emerging policy context, and the similarities and differences between the INSPIRE Directive and the High Value Datasets Implementing Regulation.
